FastRBF Software End-User License Agreement

IMPORTANT – READ CAREFULLY: FARFIELD TECHNOLOGY LIMITED (FFT) IS WILLING TO GRANT TO YOU A LICENSE FOR THE FASTRBF SOFTWARE, THE LICENSE FILE (AS DEFINED IN CLAUSE 1) AND ANY ACCOMPANYING MEDIA INCLUDING PRINTED OR ELECTRONIC MATERIALS (THE **SOFTWARE**) ONLY IF YOU ACCEPT ALL THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT. PLEASE READ THIS AGREEMENT CAREFULLY, BECAUSE USING THE SOFTWARE WILL BE DEEMED TO BE YOUR ACCEPTANCE THAT YOU ARE USING IT ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS. ANY INCONSISTENT OR ADDITIONAL TERMS OR CONDITIONS PROPOSED BY YOU ARE REJECTED AND WILL NOT BIND FFT IN ANY WAY.

IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT DO NOT DOWNLOAD, INSTALL OR USE THE SOFTWARE AND, IF APPLICABLE, RETURN THIS PRODUCT PROMPTLY, INCLUDING ALL PACKAGING AND WRITTEN MATERIALS, TO FFT, FOR A FULL REFUND OF YOUR LICENSE FEE (EXCLUDING ANY SHIPPING AND HANDLING FEES).

1. **License File:** You must only use the Software with an electronic license file provided to you by FFT (**License File**) that operates the Software either as an evaluation version (**Evaluation Version**) or as a fully registered version (**Registered Version**). If the Software is an Evaluation Version, you may evaluate the Software for a maximum of 30 days. The Evaluation Version may contain limitations to the functionality of the Software that do not exist in the Registered Version. If you wish to continue using the Evaluation Version beyond the 30 day evaluation period you must purchase a License File for the Registered Version through FFT's website at www.farfieldtechnology.com or by emailing FFT at sales@farfieldtechnology.com. The Registered Version may contain limitations to the functionality of the Software depending on the type of License File you purchase.
2. **License:** FFT grants you a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the Software in accordance with this Agreement. "**Use**" of the Software means loading, installing, or running the Software together with a valid License File on a computer. Regardless of the number or type of media by which the Software is provided to you (such as Software delivered to you on CD-ROM and/or downloaded by you off the Internet), you must only install one copy of the Software on one computer and be the only individual using the Software. If you are a corporation, FFT grants you the right to have individuals within your organisation use the Software provided that the Software is used only by one individual at any one time and in the manner specified above. You may install the Software on an internal multi-user platform or network provided that you purchase a License File for each separate computer on which the Software is installed or accessible from the network.
3. **Restrictions on Use:** You must not:
 - (a) copy the Software in any visual or machine-readable form, except that one copy of the Software may be made to the extent that such copying is necessary for your own backup purposes;
 - (b) translate, adapt, reverse-engineer or modify the Software other than in accordance with this Agreement;
 - (c) separate any component part of the Software for use on more than one computer;
 - (d) lend, rent, lease, transfer, assign or otherwise deal in the Software or your rights under this Agreement without the prior written consent of FFT;
 - (e) where you are an academic institution and have paid a reduced or discounted license fee, use the Software for commercial purposes or in connection with the provision of services to any person for reward, unless you pay to FFT the difference between FFT's standard license fee and the amount you originally paid.
4. **Upgrades:** FFT may offer you upgrades to the Software (**Upgrades**): (a) in the form of a new License File to be operated with your existing Software; (b) as a new version of the Software together with a compatible License File; or (c) in any other form that FFT may offer. FFT may charge you a fee for any Upgrades. All Upgrades will form part of the Software and must only be used in accordance with this Agreement.
5. **Protection of Proprietary Rights:** You acknowledge that the Proprietary Rights in the Software are vested in FFT. For the purposes of this Agreement, "**Proprietary Rights**" means all property in the Software and rights to patents, licenses, trade marks, trade names, inventions, trade secrets, copyright and know-how relating to the origin, manufacture, programming, operating and/or servicing of the Software and any

enhancements or modifications of the Software. You must maintain all copyright notices on the Software and must not remove the same. You must notify FFT immediately in writing if you know of any circumstances that suggest that any person may have unauthorised knowledge, possession or use of the Software.

6. **Confidentiality:** You must at all times, make every effort to ensure the confidentiality of the Confidential Information and use your best endeavours to bind your officers, employees and agents not to disclose, communicate, copy or reveal for any purpose whatsoever the Confidential Information except as permitted under this Agreement. For the purposes of this clause, “**Confidential Information**” means the License File, information relating to your customer account and any other information provided by FFT to you as confidential, or which from its nature and content is, or would reasonably expected to be, confidential. Your obligations under this clause will survive termination of this Agreement.
7. **Warranty:** The Software is licensed “as is” and all representations or warranties (statutory, express or implied except any which may not lawfully be excluded) are expressly excluded, including without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.
8. **Liability:** You will indemnify FFT against all claims, proceedings, demands, costs, losses and damages resulting from your use of the Software or a breach of your obligations under clause 6. FFT will not be liable under the law of tort, contract or otherwise for any direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage, including any loss of profits, however caused, arising out of the use of the Software. If any limitation or liability in this Agreement is invalid for any reason and FFT becomes liable for loss or damage that would otherwise have been excluded, such liability will be limited to the total amount actually paid by you for the Software.
9. **Default and Termination:** FFT may terminate this Agreement immediately by notice in writing to you if you breach any of your obligations under this Agreement and fail to remedy the breach within 30 days after notice from FFT requiring the breach to be remedied. Within 10 days of termination of this Agreement you must deliver to FFT, or destroy all copies of, the Software in whatever form possessed by you.
10. **Notice:** Any notice to be given in terms of this Agreement must be made in writing, email or by facsimile transmission sent to the address notified by either party to the other from time to time. Any communication by email or facsimile transmission will be deemed to be received when transmitted to the correct email or facsimile transmission address of the recipient and any communication in writing will be deemed to be received when left at the specified address of the recipient or the day following the date of posting.
11. **Governing Law:** This Agreement is subject to the laws of New Zealand and you submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the New Zealand courts.
